A group of Italian residents in Endicott founded and organized the Society Duca Degli Abruzzi for mutual protection and development. The lodge took its name from Luigi Amadeo, Duke of the Abruzzi, who was an Italian nobleman, mountaineer and explorer of the royal House of Savoy. He is known for his Arctic explorations and for his mountaineering expeditions, particularly to Mount Saint Elias (Alaska–Yukon) and K2 (Pakistan–China). He also served as an Italian admiral during World War I.

#### 1915

The lodge accepts an offer to become a unit of the Order of Sons of Italy in America.

#### 1921

George F. and George W. Johnson donate the land for the lodge building and each man donates \$10,000 to the lodge building fund.

#### 1923

Ground broken for building on Odell Avenue.

#### 1924

George F. Johnson added to the building fund with a donation of \$10,000 in Italian Treasury bonds. Opening night festivities featured opera singers, beginning a tradition of opera performers at the lodge that continued into the 1950s.

#### 1933

Women's lodge under the name Prinicipessa Maria Di Piemonte is formed. Later is renamed The Daughters of Columbus Lodge No. 1666.

#### 1937

Columbus Celebration and Burning of the Mortgage, Sunday, October 10, 1937. "After 22 years of hard work and earnest effort members of Italo-American colony of Endicott have cleared the debt from the Duca Delgi Abruzzi Clubhouse of the

Sons of Italy and they celebrated with a mortgage burning ceremony, banquet and dance in their lodge rooms. George W. Johnson, friend of the lodge since its inception, burned the mortgage and gave a brief address." Endicott Bulletin, Monday, October 11, 1937

The 1937 Columbus Day Festival Dance gave away a door prize of a new Chevrolet car. The winning ticket holder was Andrew Spence of Vestal, NY.

#### 1938

Sons of Italy Lodges in New York State begin campaign to boost sales of Endicott-Johnson shoes. "Taking the initial step in their campaign to boost Endicott Johnson' shoes throughout New York State, members of the Duca degli Abruzzi, 443, Lodge of the Sons of Italy in Endicott visited the North Side E.J. Retail Store last Saturday and each purchased a pair of Endicott Johnson shoes." Endicott Johnson Workers Daily News, Monday, May 16, 1938.

#### 1939

Endicott Lodge initiates naturalization drive of all Italian residents in Endicott.

#### 1966

Celebrates 51st Anniversary with a banquet on Saturday, October 8, 1966. Dancing followed dinner to the music of Alex Apalovich and his orchestra.

#### 1990

Celebrates 75th Diamond Anniversary with a banquet on October 13, 1990. The Lodge sponsored an essay contest, "The Italian Influence on American Society", as part of their 75th Anniversary year celebrations. The three winners were: Miss Patricia Giorgi, U-E HS senior, Mr. Chris Tedesco, M-E HS senior, and Miss Jennifer Lasky, U-E HS senior. After dinner music was provided by Los Vega.

#### MAKE ELABORATE PLAN FOR SONS OF ITALY FETE

All Endicott Invited to Take Part in Dedication of Temple Parades, Speeches, Banquet and Celebration Scheduled

"With program (on May 9, 2024) beginning at 2 o'clock in the afternoon and lasting until late in the evening, the Sons of Italy on Friday will dedicate their new temple in Oak Hill Avenue (sic). All of Endicott is invited to take part in the festivities, and the day is expected to be one of the gala events of the year.

"George F. Johnson will officially open the temple at 2 o'clock. The keys will be given into his keeping and his will be the honor of first throwing open to the public the building which he has done much to make possible.

"The Building Committee to whom a great deal of credit due...: Anthony Nardini as president Eugenio Sbarra as secretary and Frank Picciano as treasurer....other members L. Egidi, F. Ausili, J. Picciano, P. Rizzuto, G. Rizzuto, E. Antonelli, Rag. De Prisco, N. Camarda, C. Iacovelli, G. Longo,, P. Audino, P. Santodonato, C. Arcangeli, N. Minni, M. D'Aloisio, F. Mosca, L. Gigante, C. Parsi, F. Cascio, G. Lozzi, E. Zicari, L. Palazzo, A. Santacroce, P. Imola, C. Iacovelli, S. Cinotti, F. Perzolla and M. Riolo.

"Officers of the Lodge (in 1924) are: Frank Allio, Venerable; Michael D. Riolo, Asst. Venerable; Michael D'Aloisio, Ex-Venerable; Ignazio Saraceno, orator; Frank Picciano, treasurer; Eugenio Sbarra, corresponding secretary; Leonard Gigante, financial secretary; Joe Picciano, F. U. M secretary

"Trustees: Louis Egidi, Gerardo Palombo, Camillio Iacovelli, Enrico Antonelli and Antonio Ancona."

"Masters of ceremonies: Paul Santodonato, Cesar Arcangeli, F. Desanctis, member benefactor.

"In a fine program-booklet which the lodge has published in connection with the celebration, high tribute is paid to George F. Johnson and George W. Johnson, who have done much for the Sons of Italy. Of George F. the lodge says:

"He is the real and true philanthropist of this community; and he has always contributed to our welfare with his conspicuous donation, giving to us proof of this generous heart."

"He is the president of the great Endicott-Johnson Corporation in which are working over 16,000 people (and 2,000 of them are Italians), whom he has ever helped in their need. ..., his great soldier of the shoe industry shall never be forgotten by the soldiers of the World War; he donated \$450,00 to the American Legion for the erection of the posts in Binghamton, NY, Johnson City, NY and Endicott, NY. "

"But his generosity has no restrictions nor racial prejudice for he loves all the honest, sincere and efficient workers. So he once more manifested the greatest of his heart and open-handedly he contributed toward the building of the Temple in Endicott, NY for the "Sons of Italy" Loggia Duca Degli Abruzzi, No. 443. He donated to said Lodge \$10,000 in cash and \$10,000 in Italian bonds carrying a dividend of  $6\frac{1}{2}$  per annum for the maintenance of the new temple."

# HUNDREDS MAKE SONS OF ITALY CELEBRATION BIG SUCCESS

May 9, 1924: "Despite the stormy weather on Friday, the dedication of the Sons of Italy Temple was a spectacular success, and many hundreds of persons took part in the celebration. In the afternoon the grand opening was held and at night there was a great banquet and dance.

"George F. Johnson was an honor(ed) guest in the afternoon, and his was the duty of formally opening the temple.

"The automobile bearing Mr Johnson and his son, George W. Johnson to the ceremonies, was met at Oak Hill Avenue by the George W. Johnson Band and the members of Duca Degli Abruzzi Lodge No. 443, Sons of Italy. Between a double column of the members, and headed by the band and high officers of the local, state and national orders, the Johnson car was led to the doors of the temple in Odell Avenue.

"Here Mr. Johnson opened the doors to the temple and all marched into the auditorium. Anthony Nardini, chairman of the building committee, acted as master of ceremonies and introduced the chairman of the afternoon, Rev. Lusci, who introduced Mr. Johnson by pointing to a picture of him under which were the words, "Our Benefactor".

"'No expression of mine could serve to introduce the speaker, better than these two words,' he said. As Mr. Johnson stepped forward to speak, everyone in the hall arose and cheered.

Mr. Johnson went on to praise the organization about the fact that the Temple had already been paid for and encouraged everyone to also try to keep themselves out of debt.

"Giovanni di Silvestre, supreme venerable of the national order accepted the building on behalf of the National Order. He requested the permission of Mr. Johnson to propose his name for honorary members in the order.

"He was followed by Louis Cucca, a brilliant New York City attorney, representing Salvator Cotille, former State Senator and present grand venerable of the New York State Sons of Italy.

"A feast was served at 7 o'clock in the dining room of the clubhouse. Besides the honored guests, the members of the building committee and a few invited friends attended.

"Following the dinner a reception and dance was held in the auditorium. The Kings of Melody Orchestra of Binghamton played for the dinner and the dance which followed.

"The Sons of Italy Lodge gave to George F. Johnson a very beautiful basket of roses and carnations."
