Son's of Italy Election Process

As you already know last month we installed new officers for the years of 2013 and 2014. Their names are mention on anther page in this bulletin. *These officers will represent about 550 members, their families and community that the Son's of Italy serves for the years of 2013-14.*

The election committee of 2013 and 2014 would like to write a letter to inform members of how this election process works, and how members can apply for these positions in the future.

To understand how this process works we will start with a graph of the Son's of Italy organizational structure and a description of each officer's functions. >

President the 1st and 2ed President: These positions coordinate all the organizations functions and individuals who volunteer to run these functions. To make sure these functions move smoothly to implement them in accordance to the policies and agenda of the organization.

Recording Secretary: This position keeps written records of all meeting

Sentinels 2: These positions guard the door to make sure that late members are let into the meeting without interrupting the flow of that meeting.

Ceremonial Officers 2: These positions are responsible for the inductions of new members.

Orator: This position is responsible at every meeting to recite our mission statement, to lead in the pledge of allegiance and say a prayer.

Treasurer: This position is responsible to keep the accounting books.

Financial Secretary: This position is responsible for keeping up to date memberships lists and money from membership dues.

Trustees: These positions act as liaisons between the officers and the member. To help bring new ideas that the membership has that have the possibility to make the Son's of Italy grow, and bring these ideas to the officers for consideration to be implemented. They also encourage members to volunteer and act as good will ambassadors both to membership and to the outside community on the behalf of the Son's of Italy.

Now how can a member become an officer?

Any member with regular status can apply! Then a member would have to go to an interview. In the interview the same set of questions are asked for any regular members that come forward who are interested in any officer's positions. There is no right or wrong answers to these questions. The functions of these questions are to create a mind set of a thought process needed to succeed in these positions. *Please note any regular member who comes to an interview will be put on the ballot for that position they interviewed for when the actual vote takes place.*

The Son's of Italy Interview Process

These interview processes are implemented and design for the purpose for selecting future officers for the Endicott Lodge.

The purpose of this interview is to implement, create and design an interview process that not only questions an individual about everyday functions of the job, problem-solving skills but also questions a individuals ability to create a vision for the future.

This interview process will ask future candidates three types of questions. One can they perform the everyday function of the position. Two questions that test their problem solving skill as it relates to every day function of the job. Three do they have vision to see the club progress in the next 5 years both as a lodge, as part of community involvement and the development of the North Side of Endicott. All candidates for any officer's positions have gone through this interview process.

Type one question's about everyday functions of the Candidates.

- 1) Will you help out when the President ask?
- 2) Will you attend officers and general meeting every month?
- 3) Will you bartend once a year?
- 4) If you see someone doing something wrong do you bring it to that member attention?

Type two question's about problem solving skills.

- 1) What do you see as a major problem (other than financial) with the lodge?
- 2) What can be done to increase the amount of time member volunteers?
- 3) What to do to make sure members pay their dues on time?

Type three question's about the ability to create a direction and vision.

- 1) Where do you see the lodge progressing in 5years?
- 2) Where do you see the lodge as part of the North Side of Endicott's community in 5 years? As part of the community in general?
- 3) Do you consider your self a leader or follower or both?
 - 4) How would you establish and maintain positive relationships with member, the community and outside interested parties?

How does the member find out about these officers positions and volunteer opportunities?

By checking are website by reading our quarterly bulletin and checking the bulletin board when you come to lodge. Most likely it will read something like the advertisement below.

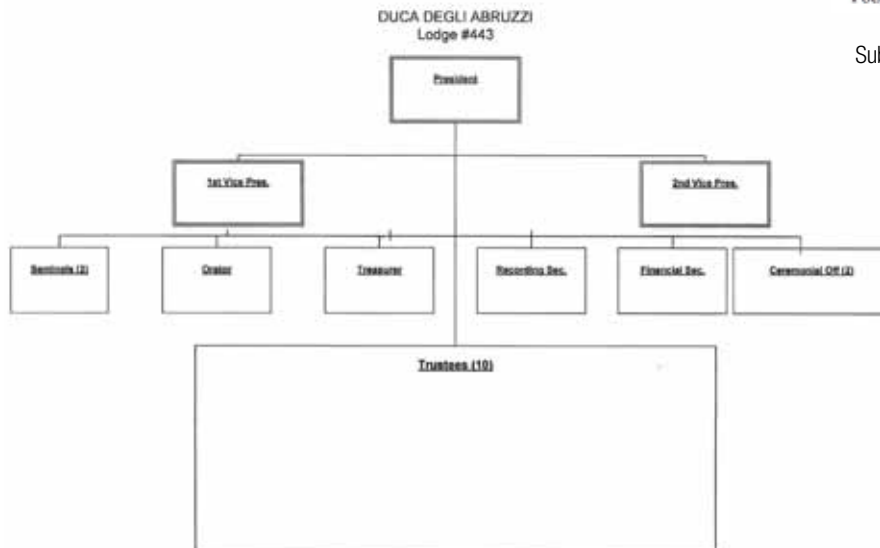

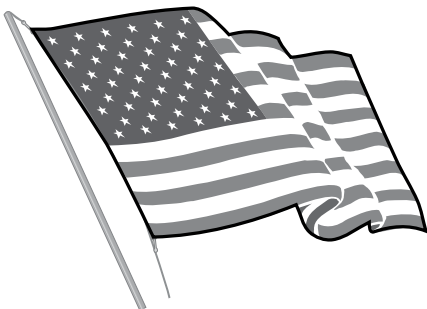

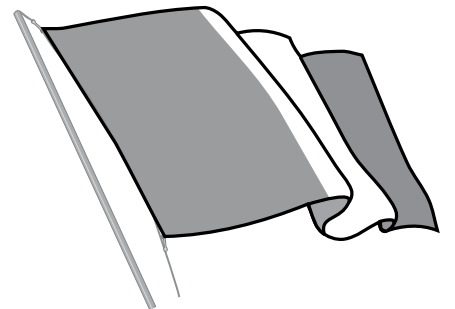
